


- <u>Perdue Foods</u> (branded chicken, and turkey products distributed through retail, food service, and international customers)

- Cultural Practices: Rotation, Corn Maturity, Soybean Maturity, Tillage Practices, Management Level
- Agronomic Challenges: Pests, Fertility, Disease
- History of Cover Cropping
- Goals of the Grower Motivation for using Cover Crops
- Soils
- There is no one Perfect Strategy for everyone

- Cost- Seed Budgets generally \$15-30 per acre
- Timing & Practicality

## Common Cover Crop Practices

- Rye- Planted on both livestock (Dairies) and row crop operations
- 2 to 12 species Cover Mixes including Grasses, Legumes, and Brassicas
- Custom Blends gaining popularity with Growers and Retailers
- Quality Early Maturing Corn and Soybean Genetics
- Planting Tillage Radish with Winter Wheat and Barley grain crops at 1lb/acre
- Interseeding Corn
- Dawn Biologic Cover Crop

## Nutrient Management

- Livestock Growers have wider spread windows with Cover Crops
- Higher field nutrient retention
- Cover Crops are becoming a staple in nutrient management plans
- Reduction of manure runoff
- Nutrient cycling

## **HEAR Rapeseed**

- High Eurcic Acid Rapeseed Winter Annual similar to Canola
- 2015-2016 500 acres planted in Pennsylvania and Delaware
- Targeting 5,000 acres for 2016-2017
- Planted 6 weeks prior to Killing Frosts (Mid September)
- Harvested in Late June
- Perdue Provides Agronomic and Management Support







## Organic Cover Crops

- Cover Crops are required in Organic Crop Rotation – Legumes!
- Clover frost seeded into Wheat
- Rye for No-Till Soybeans
- Annual Rye Grass mixes for Tillage Operations
- Hairy Vetch- management challenges
- Winter Annual crops allow for the use of many different cover crop species to address issue

## Organic Cover Crops...

- Tillage Radish mixes for compaction and weeds
- Sudangrass/Millet mixes with Sunn Hemp to control weeds, add biomass, and frost kill
- Buckwheat and Oats weed competition and biomass
- Keep the soil covered
- Winter Annuals allow greatest diversity of Cover Crops in rotation

## Organic Cover Crops...

- Winter mixes: Cereal grains, legume, canola/rapeseed: Diversity above and below the soil line
- Diverse environment for beneficial insects
- Cover Crop Strips: Planting crops in strips vs contiguous fields for biodiversity
- Interseeding corn at V4-V6, weed competition, ground cover, longer maturity corn
